### PAYMENT

# This year we are adjusting our payment plan to suit you better!

### Please read our new payment information below.

We ask for a deposit of £100 to be paid upon booking and receipt of the deposit invoice and terms and conditions document. This deposit is non-refundable.

The further £800 is to be paid up to 3 months before our visit. If this date lands during a school holiday period, the expected payment date will be prior to the holiday start. All payment dates will be specified on invoices.

Alternatively the full payment of £900 can be paid on a single invoice if requested.

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### These asks help the day run smoothy!

- Whilst our set is not confirmed yet for this production, we typically require a **hall space larger than 8m x 8m.**
- We are **unable to take down the set for lunch time**. Please reach out to us if this is an issue.
- On the day we will require a **parking space** for one vehicle. This is to ease our arrival time and help us get in and set up ready for the shows.
- We will require a space with **access to plug sockets** to run our technical equipment.
- The performance is for **12 participants** at a time. This allows for quality time for each participant with the sensory materials.

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Moonbeam Theatre is dedicated to creating innovative multisensory theatre for young individuals with Special Educational Needs, more specifically Profound and Multiple Learning Disabilities; providing them with opportunities to explore and discover in a playful and engaging atmosphere. We aim to create work that is accessible; inviting audiences that may not always feel included by the arts to experience interactive and collaborative theatre.

Our audience is at the heart of all we do, which is why we create shows that not only accommodate the needs of their audiences, but also incorporates each individual into the fabric of the performance.

#### OUR GOALS



**Creativity for all** - we believe everyone has a creative potential and everyone should have the opportunity to express themselves in a creative and safe environment. We aim for our work to create an environment where audiences feel comfortable to freely express themselves and feel inspired.



**Inclusivity and accessibility** - our work is centred around bringing accessible and inclusive theatre to our audiences. We tailor our work to each participant, ensuring they are included and can fully immerse themselves in the experience. We aim for all audiences to come away with a positive experience.



A Creative Community – we aim to form a community of SEN schools who will provide cultural enrichment for their students. Theatrical engagement will improve children's wellbeing and creative education; by providing this year on year we aim to boost the mental health of the pupils we reach.
